# Giacomo Girolamo Casanova

Signature Drink <sup>(H/2/9)</sup>

Casanova's reputation preceded him: He was known everywhere for his erotic escapades and his art of seduction. The sweet, fruity drink with notes of almond and apricot, harmoniously complemented by spicy ginger ale and cocktail bitters, is a tribute to his amorous life.

**Giacomo Girolamo Casanova (April 2, 1725 – June 4, 1798)**

On December 1, 1756, at the beginning of the Seven Years' War, Casanova visited Augsburg. The adventurer and writer had escaped from imprisonment in Venice shortly before his visit. Arriving in Augsburg, he reserved the entire hotel and also had some romantic encounters here. He enjoyed his life and lived exuberantly, but died in complete poverty.

# Nicolas Ruinart

Ruinart speaks for itself. The popular, world-renowned champagne is the main ingredient in this signature drink. The Shiso leaves lend it an aromatic and slightly minty flavor reminiscent of cinnamon, curry, cumin, anise and coriander. Herbal, fruity-sweet flavors meet the fresh brioche flavors of the champagne.

**Nicolas Ruinart (April 4, 1697 – April 21, 1769)**

In the 18th century, a large number of wine merchants from Germany and France stayed at our hotel. Just like the founder of the first Champagne house (dating back to 1729), Nicolas Ruinart, who stayed here on March 26, 1761. The former cloth merchant initially gave away his wines as promotional gifts until they were allowed to be bottled by royal decree, and champagne quickly became a popular drink.



# Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

This spicy, bitter-tart cocktail with soothing notes of bergamot is a reference to Mozart's favorite drink: punch. The traditional ingredients of punch are arrack, sugar, lemon and tea. It is said that Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was introduced to it in 1764 during a trip to England. - 'Cheers!' or 'Prost!', as we say here.

## Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (January 27, 1756 – December 5, 1791)

At the end of the Seven Years' War, in June 1763, the child prodigy Wolfgang Mozart began his three-year concert tour of Western Europe. Together with his family from Augsburg, he stayed at our hotel on his way there and back. At the same time, we also hosted Antonio Salieri, his greatest competitor, as well as the famous violin virtuoso Pietro Nardini, who was held in high esteem by Mozart's father.





# Johann Wolfgang von Goethe

Goethe was a great wine lover and not averse to alcohol. He wrote lines such as: 'What we're in need of, that full well you know: We want to sip strong drinks!' And: 'Sorrow is part of our life, but an antidote to sorrow lies in grapes.' We have taken these quotes to heart and present this cocktail as a tribute to Goethe. Acidity and fruity sweetness balance each other out, accompanied by cucumber and raisin notes - a perfect harmony.

**Johann Wolfgang von Goethe (August 28, 1749 - March 22, 1832)**

In March 1790, on his second trip to Italy to pick up the duchess Anna Amalia, Goethe stayed at the hotel "The White Lamb" in Augsburg. On his return trip from Venice in June 1790, accompanied by the duchess, he stayed at our hotel. These were the only two times Goethe visited Augsburg.

# Jacob Grimm

The Brothers Grimm are well-known until today for their collection of fairy tales. This cocktail was created in reference to one of their most famous fairy tales: Snow White. 'Skin as white as snow, lips as red as blood, hair as black as ebony.' - This fruity drink with earthy-floral notes would steal the show even from 'Snow White over the mountains, with the seven dwarfs.' Some tannins and the slightly sour, refreshing apple-elderflower espuma are its crowning glory.

## **Jacob Grimm (January 4, 1785 – September 20, 1863)**

On July 17, 1815, the Minister of State of Electorate of Hesse, Count von Keller, arrived with Jacob Grimm, who together with his brother Wilhelm had created the famous collection of fairy tales. The philologist and fairy tale writer had been taken into diplomatic service with the Elector of Hesse and acted as legation secretary at the Congress of Vienna. Grimm, however, felt like a 'diplomat against his will' and preferred to pursue his personal interests in Vienna.



# König Ludwig I. von Bayern

A hundred years before Ludwig was born, a grain spirit with added herbs and spices was produced in the Netherlands, called Genever. The most important ingredient was juniper. Since Ludwig's third name was August, it instantly made us think of Augsburg's 'August Gin'. In this fruity-sour cocktail, the gin makes up the base spirit. With its bitter-sweet aroma, it creates the perfect balance to mango and rhubarb.

## Ludwig I, King of Bavaria (August 25, 1786 – February 29, 1868)

Welcomed by a cheering crowd, the King of Bavaria arrived at our hotel to visit the military camp near Augsburg on August 31, 1838. He wanted to attend the maneuvers together with Crown Prince Friedrich Wilhelm, Prince Karl and Prince Max of Leuchtenberg, the Prince of Saxony-Altenburg, the Grand Duke of Hesse and the Prince of Thurn and Taxis. On June 23, 1841, he visited Augsburg again, this time with his wife, Queen Therese of Bavaria, and their children Prince Luitpold and Princess Adelgunde. The royal family traveled to Augsburg by the newly opened railroad.



# Kaiser Napoleon III. von Frankreich

Just like Napoleon, Cognac and Chartreuse come from France. The brandy and the liqueur were created during the Middle Ages and have been perfected over the years. The fresh, slightly tart drink boasts pleasant herbal and citrus aromas, which are supported by the champagne.

## Kaiser Napoleon III. von Frankreich (20.04.1808 – 09.01.1873)

In 1867, yet another emperor visited Augsburg: Napoleon stayed with us that summer, together with Empress Eugenie, passing through on their way to Salzburg. After the war between Prussia and Austria had created new political facts, he was on a political mission. They arrived on August 17 and visited the Anna Gymnasium, the school which he had attended from 1822 to 1823. Napoleon III had been in exile in Augsburg with his mother Hortense de Beauharnais from 1817 to 1825 after the fall of Napoleon Bonaparte, and had therefore been familiar with the city and our hotel from childhood.





# Richard Wagner

Not averse to alcohol, the composer cherished an impressive wine collection. His wine cellar held 180 bottles of red wine, 128 bottles of white wine, seven bottles of champagne, as well as 41 bottles of cognac and other spirits. 'Perfect,' we thought. This cocktail is bitter, surprisingly fruity, and rich in citrus and bell pepper notes.

#### Richard Wagner (May 22, 1813 - January 13, 1883)

In October 1868, the composer stayed at our hotel with Cosima von Bülow and her two children, as well as their common daughter and a nanny. On such occasions, we had the opportunity to demonstrate the quality of our cuisine, which was already legendary at the time. In 1886, one banquet was followed by another at our hotel. This was also the case at the opening of the Swabian Exhibition that year, where music by Richard Wagner and others was played.

# Rudolf Diesel

## Signature Drink

In 1898, Diesel's first factory was founded in Augsburg. The distillery of our base spirit Benriach was built in the same year by John Duff. The spicy and strong drink with noticeable sherry and fruit flavors is something for everyone – even for gasoline engine drivers.

### **Rudolf Diesel (March 18, 1858 – September 29, 1913)**

After France declared war on Germany in 1870, the Diesel family was expelled and moved to London; Rudolf went to Augsburg the same year. After trade school, the highly gifted young man attended industrial school and then the technical college in Munich. In 1881, he met Heinrich Buz, the director of Maschinenfabrik Augsburg (MAN). There he started to develop the diesel engine in 1893. Diesel was a member and shareholder of Dieselmotorenfabrik Augsburg AG, which was founded in 1898 but was unable to maintain itself alongside Maschinenfabrik Augsburg and Maschinenfabrik L. A. Riedinger. The first diesel engine installed in our hotel in 1898 came from the Riedinger company.



# Ferdinand Graf von Zeppelin

In 1896, not only did Zeppelin become a member of the Association of German Engineers, which supported his airship project; that same year, the original recipe for Galliano Vanilla was created by Arturo Vaccari in Tuscany. Fittingly, Zeppelin's wife was a passionate gardener who grew her own herb garden. The refreshing, citrusy drink is reminiscent of Tuscany and captivates with balancing aromas of vanilla and herbs.

**Ferdinand Graf von Zeppelin (July 8, 1838 – March 8, 1917)**

On May 25, 1900, a few weeks before the launch of his first airship on Lake Constance, the airship designer came to Augsburg and signed our guest book. Since the Riedinger company had manufactured the gas cells for Zeppelin's first airship in 1899, the count was already familiar with Augsburg. A few years later, his successor Hugo Eckener also stayed at our hotel.

# Franklin D. Roosevelt

Take your time to enjoy and experience the full variety of flavors in this drink. Roosevelt was an avid cigar smoker - with this drink, we bring back his and the Peaky Blinders era. The initial smoky notes of Mezcal slowly give way to the caramel and maritime notes of the whiskey.

**Franklin D. Roosevelt (January 30, 1882 - April 12, 1945)**

In 1905, Roosevelt and his wife Eleanor stayed with us in Augsburg on their honeymoon. Later, FDR was known for his many extramarital affairs, including with Lucy Mercer, his wife's private secretary. In 1933, Franklin D. Roosevelt was appointed 32nd President of the United States and held that post until his death.



# Hermann Hesse

Hesse had a special relationship with wine – he owned a vineyard in his adopted home in Montagnola in Ticino. That's why we decided to use brandy, a wine spirit, in his cocktail. Light spiciness harmonizes perfectly with fruity aromas of orange and basil in this drink.

## Hermann Hesse (July 2, 1877 – August 9, 1962)

The writer visited Augsburg several times and liked to stay overnight, including on November 15, 1925. Hesse had just arrived from Switzerland, as he was on a lecture tour that also took him to Augsburg. He reported the following about his stay: 'The hotel omnibus in Augsburg dropped me off in front of a revolving glass door, from behind which came the sound of tea music, this witty invention of today's man so that he does not have to speak, pay attention, think or turn inward even in those few moments of rest and relaxation. I announced myself and asked for a room (...). A door was opened in front of me, a tall, beautiful room was there, with the window opening onto a green conservatory. I was delighted to take possession of the most original and pretty hotel I have ever encountered in a major German city(...).'

# Richard Strauss

Strauss' mother came from one of the richest families in Munich: the Pschorr brewery dynasty. But since we thought that beer would be too simple, we dug a little deeper and came across Strauss' favorite dessert: 'Karthäuser Klösse', sweet dumplings, accompanied by cranberries and coffee. The fruity drink with slight acidity is balanced by the bitter-sweet espuma.

## Richard Strauss (June 11, 1864 - September 9, 1949)

The composer from Munich stayed with us in 1933. Together with his family, he attended the performance of his ballet 'The Legend of Joseph' at the new open-air theater at the 'Rotes Tor'. In Augsburg, Strauss also conducted his operas 'Arabella' and 'Elektra'. The Augsburg Theater was an interesting venue for composers at that time, because it regularly performed contemporary works by d'Albert, Puccini, Strauss, Hindemith, Krenek, Pfitzner or Weill in addition to the classical repertoire.





# Zarah Leander

Among them were Heidi Schmid, Marika Kilius, Hans Jürgen Bäuml, Oleg Protopopov, Lyudmilla Belousova, Roberto Blanco, Udo Jürgens, Hildegard Knef and many more. In 1963, the famous Swedish actress and singer Zarah Leander also stayed with us and signed our guest book.
